Since this is true, one of the most important things we can do is to put together some good tools to help us understand the Bible and thus to grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18).

### ***The Indispensable Helps***

#### *The Reformation Study Bible*

For years I have said this is the best study Bible on the market. I still believe it is among the top two. I recommend it as a person's first and main study Bible since it has the best easy-to-use theological articles, has very good notes at the bottom of each page on the text itself, contains excellent book introductions, and is easier to carry than some other options.

#### *The ESV Study Bible*

I would also encourage a person to get their hands on this great tool. By far, it has better notes at the bottom of the page on the biblical text than any other option. It also has great treatments of the entire message of the Bible and how everything fits together, as well as an on-line version to which every owner is given access.

Between the notes and articles in these two study Bibles, few other reference resources would ever be needed by most Christians.
