

Simple Tool For Application Of *One To One Bible Reading*

Please follow this guide as you prepare for a meeting or while you meet.

Request God's help to understand (as you start) and apply the passage (as you end). (While preparing pray that God will guide your preparation and help in the upcoming meeting)

Examine the passage together, which starts by reading it out loud and then includes talking together. (While preparing do this with a view for how you will discuss the passage with the other person)

Meaning

Two of the simplest questions: "What does the passage say about God?" "What does it say about me or other people?" (Not found in the book)

Application

Two of the simplest questions: "What should I do with what the passage says?" "With whom can I share this message this week?"

Apply the passage daily to life by sharing with each other ways you plan to do this. (While preparing do this with a view for how you will discuss the passage with the other person)

Determine the time of your next meeting together.
